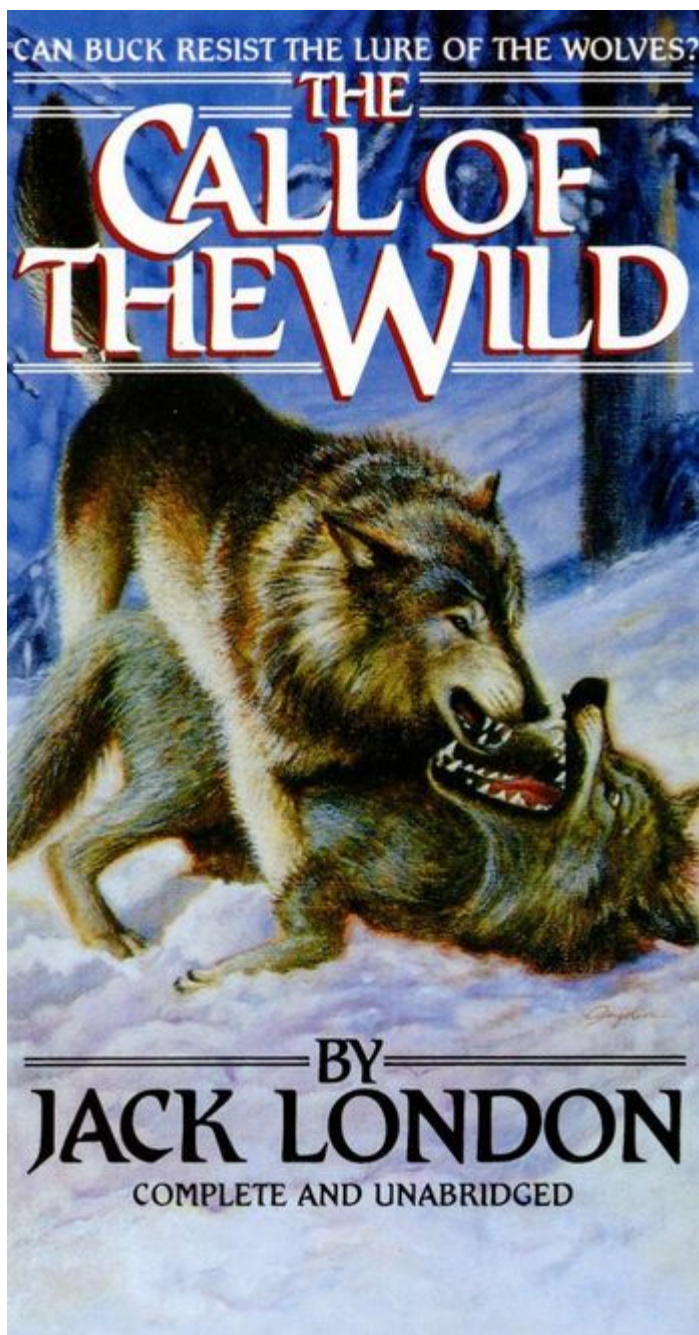

The Call of the Wild was written by Jack London in 1903. There are 102 pages. The Call of the Wild is an adventure novel which speaks about a domestic dog called Buck who was having a comfortable and peaceful life in Santa Clara Valley in California. But one day, a gardener helper who had debts, sold him to dog traders. So Buck had to learn the hard life in the cold North to become stronger and more clever. Yes, I was very proud of me because I never thought I could adapt to this life in the Yukon and face all the problems I had.

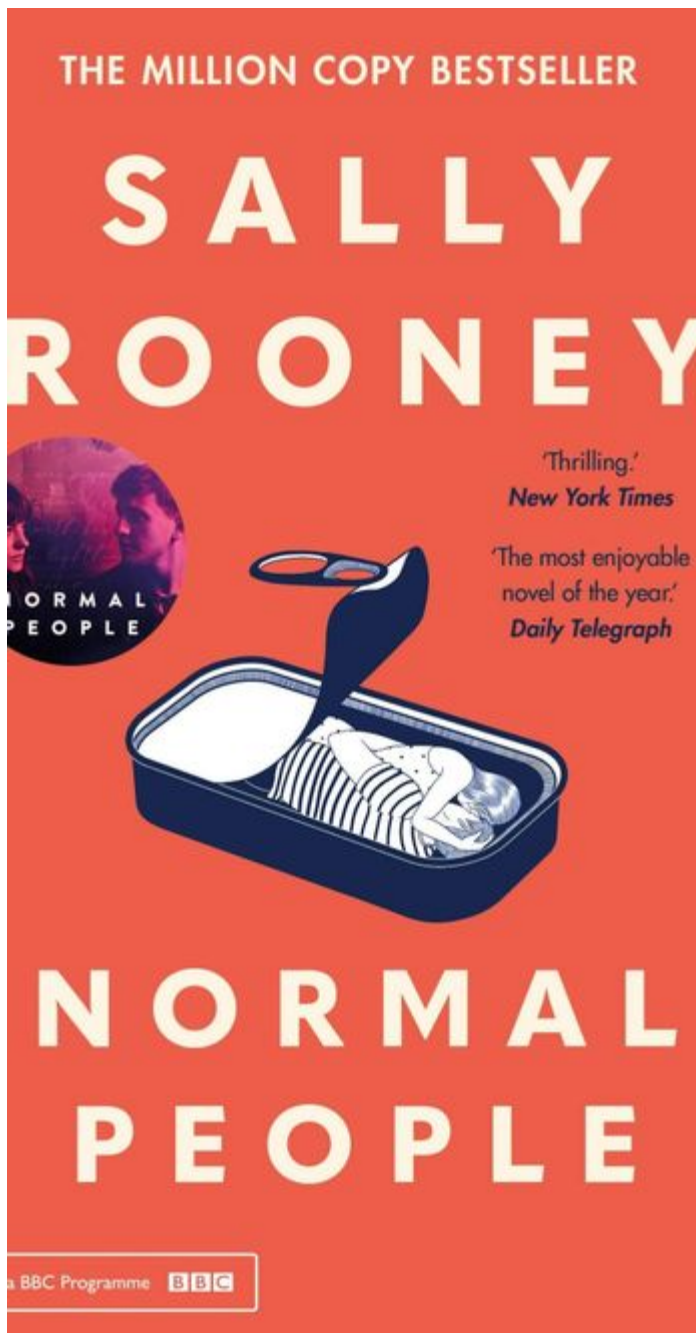
• What do you think of Charles, Mercedes and Hal ?

Author : Why has your relationship with her changed ?

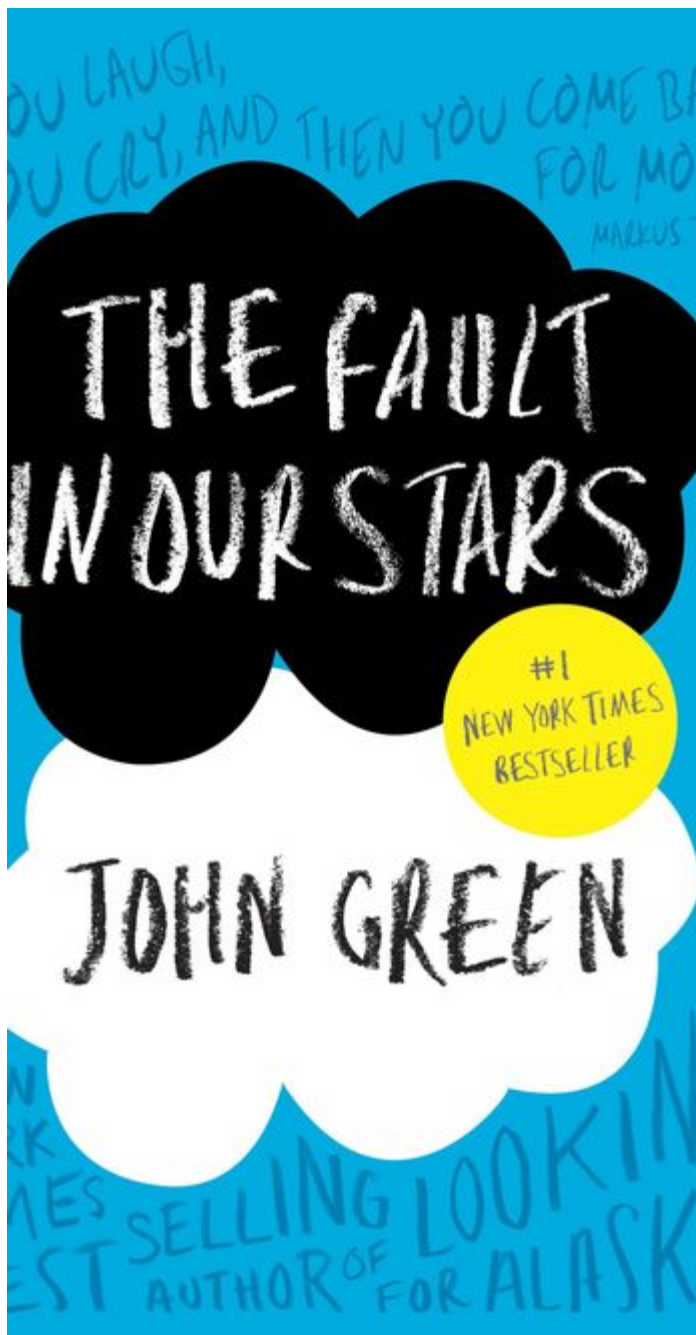
Connell : My relation with her changed because I developed some feelings/emotions for her and we started a secret relationship.

The Hunger Games

◇ *The Hunger Games* By Suzanne Collin first published in the US in 2008. The book contains 454 pages with 27 chapters.

It is the first book of a trilogy. The story takes place in a dystopian future in a country called Panem, which is located in what used to be North America.

The book follows Katniss Everdeen, a 16-year-old girl from District 12, the poorest of the twelve districts. Every year, the Capitol organizes an event called « The Hunger Games », where one boy and one girl from each district are chosen to fight to death on live TV.

The Hunger Games were created to punish and maintain control over the districts after a past rebellion. Katniss's younger sister, Prim, is chosen to take part in the Games, but Katniss volunteers to take her place. Along with a boy named Peeta Mellark, they are sent to the Capitol to participate in the Games.

Inside the arena, Katniss must use her intelligence, hunting skills, and instincts to survive—not only against other tribes but also against the manipulations of the Game Makers.

◇ The book explores many important themes much as Survival: Every character must fight to stay alive, physically and mentally.

- Inequality and injustice: The Capitol is rich and powerful, while the districts suffer.

- Media manipulation: The Games are a tool to control people by fear and distract the districts from rebelling.

◇ *The Hunger Games* is more than just a story about a deadly competition. It's a powerful critique of our society, especially about power, poverty, and the role of media. Suzanne Collins created a strong heroine who inspires readers to think and question authority.
